UPMC To Host Living-Donor Kidney Virtual Town Hall

- UPMC is hosting Living Donation: Be the Perfect Match starting at noon on Thursday, Sept. 30. During the event, Amit Tevar, MD, surgical director, UPMC Kidney and Pancreas Transplant Program, and Sam Stea, MD, nephrologist, UPMC in North Central Pa., will give an overview of the living donation and evaluation process, talk about surgery and recovery, and share stories from transplant patients from north central Pa.

"It's quite simple: a living organ donor saves not just one, but two lives and it's important that people understand how they can be a life-saver through donation," said Dr. Tevar. "Close to 26 million people in the U.S. suffer from kidney disease and over 100,000 are on the waiting list for a kidney transplant. Last year, living organ donors made more than 5,700 life-saving transplant surgeries possible. By working alongside Dr. Stea and other UPMC physicians here in north central Pa., our programs are helping connect donors and recipients here in the region with UPMC's nationally recognized transplant services.'

UPMC's Kidney Evaluation Clinic opened in the spring of 2019 and offers a range of pre-kidney transplant evaluation services including blood and diagnostic tests, radiology and diagnostic imaging services and ongoing education. The transplant takes place in Pittsburgh and patients return to Williamsport for post-surgical care and follow-up. The clinic also provides transplant evaluations and information about living-donor kidney transplants.

"Our clinic aims to help those in kidney failure get donations faster by receiving a living-donor transplant, which have better outcomes and faster recovery times than deceased-donor transplants," said Dr. Stea. "The average wait time for patients in this region on the waiting list for a cadaver organ is about six years, despite the average five-year survival rate for patients on dialysis being only about 36%. We have too many people passing away on the waiting list when there's a lot of viable donors in our communities.

Goose Day is September 29. Well, not to put you in a "fowl" mood but Mifflin and Juniata Counties, our neighbors to the west, have been celebrating Goose Day for many years. Restaurants and churches throughout the county offer goose dinners and people flock from near and far for a taste of it. An old proverb states that "If you eat goose on Michaelmas Day, you will never want money all the year round."

What is Goose Day? Goose Day is actually Michaelmas Day also known as St. Michael and All Angels Day. Pope Felix III declared Michaelmas Day a festival in 480 A.D. It soon became a popular day in England to honor Archangel Michael, the prince of guardian angels. In England on Michaelmas Day elections of civil magistrates

would take place because elected officials acted as guardians and protectors of the people. The traditional St. Michael's Day dinner includes roast goose based on the old proverb.

Rents were also paid on Michaelmas Day. To ensure their rents would be renewed, tenants would give their landlords a goose.

In Pennsylvania the German settlers adapted the custom from their English neighbors over 200 years ago. Legend has it that Andrew Pontius, a Dutchman, settled in Snyder County from Bucks County. He found himself in need of a tenant farmer to work the land. He eventually found a young Englishman, Archibald Hunter, and the two drew up an agreement. Archibald Hunter insisted that his rent be paid on September 29 -Michaelmas Day.

Pontius agreed to the date not knowing why it was so important. On the next Michaelmas Day, Hunter arrived at the home of Pontius with his rent, carrying a goose under one arm. Hunter explained to Pontius that is was the custom to bring "one goose fit for the lord's dinner" with his annual rent.

So, this September 29 gobble up some goose and see if it brings you any luck! Regardless of whether or not eating goose will actually brighten your financial future, you might not want to ruffle any feathers and indulge in this German tradition!





ALL-STAR SPRINTS EIGHT RACES IN LAST FOUR WEEKS IN OUR REGION

The traveling All Star sprints have been racing in our region for three of the last four weekends, with nine different races at five different tracks, with one event rained out, and it finished up last Saturday night at Lincoln speedway. It started on Thursday August 26th at Grandview speedway with All Star regular Tyler Courtney scoring the win over Anthony Macri, and Justin Peck. Friday Williams Grove suffered a rain out, on Saturday at Lincoln speedway Cory Eliason scored another win for the All Stars over the Pa Posse, Parker-Price-Miller was second with Justin Peck third, then Sunday at Baps speedway Danny Dietrich got one for the Posse, with Hunter Schcerenberg, and Ryan Smith. Two weeks later it was the three day show at Port Royal with Brent Marks winning the first night over Brian Balog, and Daryn Pittman, the second night went to Pittman over Lucas Wolfe and Gio Scelzi. The big final paying \$54,000 to win went to Port Royal's track champion Logan Wagner, over Lance Dewease, and Zeb Wise. This past weekend Anthony Macri scored the win Friday night at Williams Grove over Lance Dewease and Brent Marks. The \$20,000 top prize Saturday at Lincoln went to Justin Peck over Freddie Rahmer and Macri. Justin Peck of Monrovia, IN., has Four ALL Star wins this season, and four wins racing in central Pa. Peck scored wins back in March 20th at Port Royal and March 26th at Williams Grove, then a Speedweek win at Lincoln speedway on June 28th Lincoln had a double heat format with point totaled for the best top 20 in the feature, while the rest ran C and B-mains to get in the show that started 28 cars, of the 49 drivers that attended the race. Spencer Bayston set fast time on the night with a clocking of 13.501, with 16-year-old Riley Emig winning the c-main and Aaron Reutzel the b-main. For the eight late season races, run in this area four wins for the Pa Posse and four for the All Stars with an average of 43-drivers on hand for the eight races with the low count of 26 at Grandview and the high of 57 at Port Royal.

Selinsgrove speedway will host the National Open for 410-sprints, and this will be one of the richest paying nonsanctioned events around with a purse over \$52,000 with the winner's part \$20,075. This is the third year the event will pay that much to win with Logan Wagner the winner in 2019 and Anthony Macri last year's winner, time trials, heats b-main to set the feature line-ups. Five features have been run so far this year at Selinsgrove with wins going to Brent Marks twice, Danny Dietrich, Chase Dietz, and Anthony Macri. The race will carry the Jim Nace Memorial for the 39th annual National Open event. Nace is the tracks only five-time champion in the 410-division, with the Nace family sponsoring the fast tees fast time award for \$300.

Other 410-sprint shows left for this season, will be the twoday WOO 59th Annual National Open at Williams Grove on Friday and Saturday October 1st and 2nd, along with a regular show this coming Friday night. The Friday night show will pay \$10,000 to win with this being the 34th annual running of the Preliminary race, the Saturday night show paying \$75,000 to win. In the 2020 events David Gravel won the Friday night show with Donny Schatz winning on Saturday. Port Royal on the weekend of October 8-9 will host their final two 410 sprints show of the season also under the WOO sanctioned. Last year Kyle Larson swept both night of racing at Port, then Trailways races on Sunday making up a rained out event back in August. Saturday October 16th Lincoln speedway will have the 410-sprint for the last time this season, with Baps speedway having the division on Saturday October 23rd, and also the final show for the season on Saturday November 13th. So far nothing is scheduled for the last weekend in October, but you never know with a rain out or weather conditions, maybe a track will try that weekend also.

Baps speedway ran a five division show last Saturday with the winged Sportsman feature going to long time Sportsman driver Frankie Herr, who is also leading the points standings with three races left this season. Herr has three wins this season and 55-point margin over Scott Dellinger who has one win and last year's champion Kenny Edkin who has the most wins in the division with four, and is still in the point chase back 155. This Saturday the division is racing for a \$3,000 top prize with late models' Extreme stocks and Legend cars also in action. Matt Murphy scored his first win at the speedway this season and the first there since the 2018 season. Matt led all 20-laps of the race and had to hold off a late race charge by four-time winner Chase Billet, who holds a 335-point margin over Ben Whitaker with two-point races left, Chase barring any major problems could wrap things up this Saturday.

Clinton County speedway is off this weekend, but will be back with two big shows to finish the season. The first will take place on Saturday October 2nd with the CW Smith race for the Pro-Stock class with \$1,800 going to the winner. The Laurel Highlands IMCA 305 sprints will have a special race paying at least \$800 going to the winner, 270 & 600 Micros and the four-cylinders will also be racing. Then on Saturday October 9th the super late models will run a special race paying the winner of the feature \$5,000 to win, along with the four other divisions racing on the same program.

410 Sprint Car National Open To Pay \$20,075 To Win!



Selinsgrove Speedway's historic 75th Anniversary Season will culminate with the track's crown jewel open wheel race, the Jim Nace Memorial 39th Annual National Open for 410 sprint cars presented by River Valley Builders, at 7 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 25.

Joining the Lelands.com 410 sprint cars will be the Apache Tree Service PASS/IMCA 305 sprint cars in the season finale. Advance ticket holder and pit gates will open at 4 p.m. with all general admission gates opening at 4:30 p.m.

The winner of the prestigious 40-lap National Open will earn \$20,075, the East's highest winner's share for a non-sanctioned sprint car race! Second-place will take home \$6,075 with thirdplace offering \$4,075! The 2021 increased purse will pay \$675 to start the main event out of the \$52,000-plus purse!

There is no cure for Parkinson's

and 60,000 new cases are diagnosed each year in the United States alone. Programs funded by the Parkinson's Foundation community grants also include wellness, dance, music therapy and educational programs that help people with Parkinson's live better with the disease. Since 2011, the Parkinson's Foundation has funded more than 580 community-based programs that help address unmet needs for people with PD.
